




"We really built the house around the sunset and the light-house," says Belinda. "We wanted to make the landscape the primary focus—keep the focus outside."


The Giving Trees

INSPIRED BY THEIR FIRST FALL VISIT, THE COUPLE NAMED THE house "Fallen Leaves." "When we first went to the site, there were a lot of leaves on the ground," says Cambridge-based architect Maryann Thompson. "The fallen leaves gave us the idea of how to let light in through the roof—just as the leaves were layering themselves on top of each other.
