


The Atlantic Center for the Arts offers artists residency programs in a lush Florida jungle setting. The Center offers residencies to writers, dancers, visual artists, composers, choreographers, and actors. Past participants include Allen Ginsberg, Lukas Foss, Robert Rauschenberg, Edward Albee, Alice Aycock, and other nationally known artists.

Charles Rose was commissioned in 1992 to design the center's workshop spaces. The program includes a black-box theater, painting and scupting studios, recording studios, a dance studio, a library and various support spaces. The design includes six buildings interwoven into an indigenous Florida jungle landscape, linked by an elevated broadwalk, and made of wood, glass and

Construction of the project is now complete, and the center celebrated its opening in February of 1997. The project completed an intensive value engineering process, and Charles Rose worked closely with the construction manager to refine building costs so that the project came in below budget.









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














